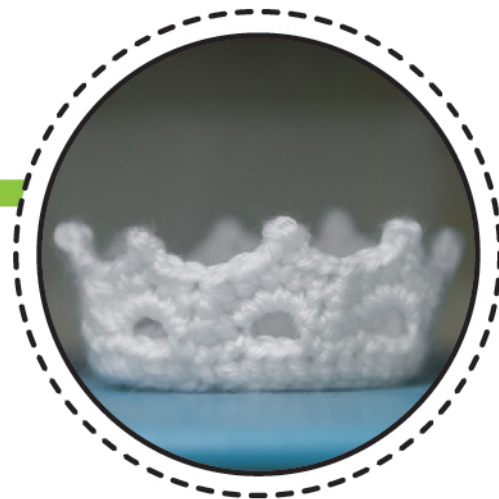


# LITTLE CROWN FOR A PRINCESS

## The pattern

Size: 8 cm height (3") in diameter  
3 mm hook  
Acrylic worsted yarn (9 wpi, 164 m/ 100 g): white



Ch 45, sl st to join into a ring.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 2, work 1 HDC in each of the stitches starting from the next one. Sl st into the second st of the initial chain-2 of this row.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 1, \* [work 1 SC into the next st, Ch 3, skip 2, work 1 SC into each of the next 2 st].

Repeat 8 more times from \*. Sl st into the initial ch-1.

**Rnd 3:** Sl st into the next st. \*[ Work 5 SC into the next 3-chain space. Work a single crochet decrease across the 3 next stitches, (Sc3tog)].

Repeat 8 more times from \*. Sl st into the next st.

**Rnd 4:** Ch 1. \* [Work 1 SC into the next st. Work 1 SC, make a picot (Ch 3, sl st into the first of ch-3) and work 1 more SC out of the same st (it should be the one on the top of the spike). Work 1 SC into the next st. SC together the next 3 st (Sc3tog)].

Repeat 8 more times from \*.

Sl st into the next stitch.

Bind off and weave in ends.

## Abbreviations

The US abbreviations are used in this patterns.

**st** for a Stitch

**sts** for Stitches

**SL ST** for a Slip Stitch

**Ch** for a Chain

**SC** for a Single Crochet

**HDC** for a Half Double Crochet (wrap the yarn once around the hook)
